Anyone riding a horse MUST wear a helmet! Class/ Division Specifications

- Indicates classes rated by Cranberry Circuit
- Hunter Hack Open to horses and ponies with riders of any age Horses to work collectively on the flat, then jump individually two jumps indicated by the Judge.
- Pony Hunter- Open to Ponies 14.2 and under, to be ridden by a Junior.
- Hopeful Hunter-Open to any age rider on a Horse or Pony, combination not to have shown over fences over 2'3"
- Limit Equitation-open to any age rider who has not shown over fences higher than 2'3".
- Cranberry Circuit Hunter Horses or ponies, riders of any age. Fences 2'6"
- Open Hunt Seat Equitation Any age amateur rider on a horse or pony. Fences 2'6"
- Cranberry Circuit Medal

Halloween Handy Hunter Pairs Class Fences 2', 2'6"
To be judged on style, pace, obedience and boldness as a hunt team!! Horse/rider combinations may compete on multiple teams. Entry fee 13.00 per rider for each team.

Beginner's Hunter and Equitation Over Fences- Open to riders who are eligible for Walk-Trot or Novice at this show.

Short Stirrup-Open to riders 13 years and under.

Long Stirrup- Open to riders 14 and older, Adults included

- Hunter Pleasure Horse- Open to horses of Hunter type.
- Hunter Pleasure Pony- Open to ponies of Hunter type.
- Lead-Line- Open to riders 8 years and under, leader must be at least 14 years old.

Senior Lead Line- Open to riders over 8 years old. Leader at least 14 years old.

Walk-Trot-Open to riders 12 years and under who have never shown at the canter.

Senior Walk-Trot- Open to riders over 12 years, Adults included, who have not shown at the canter.

Novice- Open to any age rider in their first year showing at the canter. Novice riders may also enter any other divisions for which they are qualified.

Rules And Regulations

- 1.Entry Fees: \$13.00 per class. Show management reserves the right to combine, cancel, reschedule or divide classes when deemed necessary.
- 2. All classes to be judged on performance and soundness, Judges' decisions are final.

Trophy and six ribbons to be awarded in each class.

3. Entries may be made in advance by mail, by Fax-508-759-8653, or in person the day of the show.

Pre- entries are appreciated

A \$10. post entry fee will be charged for entries made on the day of the show. There is no fee for scratches or class changes made on show day.

- 4.NO DOGS! Please do not bring your dog to the horse show.
- 5. Please, no longeing in the show rings- ample warm up space will be provided.
- 6. Absolutely no smoking within 100 feet of any building.
- 7. All riders must wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted no exceptions! This rule will be enforced!

8. Proper show attire and appropriate tack is required for each class.
